# UNIFORM POLICY

# GUIDELINES

Most uniforms are specific to Ebenezer Christian College and are available for purchase at the school office [not including shoes, socks /stockings]. Generic substitutions are not acceptable.

**Clearly and appropriately label all uniform with the current owner's name.**

Everyday uniforms and sports uniforms should not be interchanged, such as: wearing the sports jacket with everyday uniform, sports shirt with everyday skirt or trousers, sport track pants or shirt with everyday button-up etc.

During Terms 2 & 3, High School students wear blazers on top of their normal uniforms and the girls wear black stockings. Primary students wear jumpers on top of their normal uniforms and the girls wear grey stockings.

Students should not wear any item which obstructs their uniform such as hoodies, jerseys or vests. During Terms 2 & 3, students may wear a plain long-sleeved skivvy, thermal shirt or undershirt in white or grey under their uniform for additional warmth. Coloured or printed undershirts and hooded shirts or jumpers are not permitted. These should NOT be visible.

# GUIDELINES

As a general rule, if it is not specified, it should not be worn.

Students with unacceptable hairstyles, colours, or wearing makeup, nail polish or false nails will be told to remove or change these in adherence to the Uniform Policy. Students will also be told to remove any accessories which are not school colours, excessive in amount or have conspicuous styles.

In the event of a student TEMPORARILY unable to comply with the school uniform guidelines, a note of explanation from the student's parent or guardian must be presented before consideration will be given.

Consideration will only be applied to minor uniform breaches only. Minor breaches may be described as temporarily reasonable, an individual circumstance which would not be repeated or which can be easily and swiftly corrected.

Students not complying will have consequences or loss of privileges. Staff members will question all students who are not present in the correct uniform as dictated by school guidelines.

# PRESENTATION OF UNIFORM

All uniform items should be of an appropriate size to the wearer and should be replaced when excessively faded, torn, worn, undersized or oversized.

Dresses and skirts should be worn covering their knees. Skirts should not be altered in any way to prevent them from being the required length. Students will be required to replace skirts which no longer meet this requirement.



Uniforms should be kept neat and tidy. If applicable, students must tuck in all shirts excluding the sports uniform, and ties must be neatly knotted and not hanging loosely.



Dress shoes for everyday uniform should be black leather without pointed toes, or any attention-drawing features. Skaters, runners, ballet shoes, canvas, hitop boots, high-heeled shoes, sneakers etc. are not acceptable.



Students wearing uniform off campus (travelling to and from school, shopping after school, on excursions etc.) are expected to remain in complete uniform and strictly adhere to all grooming requirements.

# HAIR & MAKE UP

Students should wear their hair in a clean, neat and tidy manner and should not be unnaturally coloured or patterned. 'Unnatural colours' include colours distinctive from the student's natural hair colour. This policy includes any types of hair extensions if such extenders are necessary.



Hairstyles are to be appropriate to a professional workplace environment. Extreme hairstyles or any excess style trend [shaved, mohawks, tracks, dreadlocks, undercuts, rat tails etc.] will not be tolerated. Facial hair is not permitted for boys.



Girls' hair should be brushed clear off the face. Any hair that falls over the face should be tied or pinned back securely.

Boys' hair should be cut neatly and short, not touching the collar.

Makeup, nail polish and false nails are not permitted. Nails should be neatly trimmed.



# HATS & ACCESSORIES

As an important precaution against skin exposure, it is compulsory for all Primary students to wear hats during recess and lunch and for all sports classes and activities. While it is optional for High School students to wear hats during recess and lunch, hats are compulsory for all High School sports classes and activities.



Only hair accessories in the school colours [maroon, grey, navy blue or black] will be permitted. Students will be asked to remove any hair accessories in different colours or conspicuous styles [eg. headbands with ears].



Females with pierced ears may wear one pair of small studs in the earlobes, one in each ear. Additional earrings, fancy earrings or large earrings are not permitted, neither are males permitted to wear earrings.



Students should not wear rings, necklaces and chains while in school uniform. Other than wrist watches, students should not wear items of jewellery not mentioned above while in school uniform.
